### **Cash for Class™ Awards at WASFAA**

(March 22, 2002)--Schools can register to win *Cash for Class* for their students during the upcoming WASFAA conference April 7-9 in Boise, Idaho. NSLP's *Cash for Class* is a new scholarship program that provides money to schools in each of the six financial aid regions. *Cash for Class* provides students with funds to help pay for college expenses and to support the efforts of our financial aid colleagues.

Schools can register for *Cash for Class* at NSLP's booth at the MASFAA, RMASFAA, SWASFAA, SASFAA, EASFAA, and WASFAA conferences held October through April. Schools receive *Cash for Class* registration forms prior to each regional conference.

The school decides how to award the funds to their students to use for educational expenses. Any postsecondary school in the United States, or one of its territories, that participates in Title IV programs is eligible to register for *Cash for Class*. Schools do not need to belong to any of the six regional financial aid associations to be eligible. NSLP selects the winning school and awards the funds shortly after each regional conference.
